

# Meadowlark's Winter Walk of Lights Design Installation Specifications 2023 Season

# **Show Description**

Meadowlark's Winter Walk of Lights (WWOL) is a walk-thru light show that utilizes ¾ of a mile of Meadowlark Botanical Gardens paved trails. It consists of over a million LED lights on trees, custom made frames and a musical light show. In past years the show has had as many as 80-90,000 visitors during its six week run. The show runs from mid-November until the first week of January.

#### **General Information**

- Set up is between September 30<sup>th</sup> and October 20<sup>th</sup>.
  - Meadowlark provides all lights.
  - Lights will be staged daily in work areas.
  - All lights should be tested as they are put up.
    - Meadowlark staff will provide power at the working areas either with plugs or generators.
- Lamp cord will be provided to run up each trunk.
  - NO more than 15 strands of lights will be connected end to end.


#### **General Information**

- Trees will be flagged and numbered for reference to master list which notes all décor information.
  - Copies of a Master list and Master Map will be provided to the foreman.
- A foreman should be onsite at all times during the work and will serve as the liaison to the park staff.
  - It is the responsibility of the contracted team to clean up and leave an organized area at the end of each day.

#### **General Information**

- Lifts, ladders and all required safety equipment are to be provided by the contractor.
  - Lift users are required to be in compliance of all safety standards at all times.
    - Some areas are off limits to lifts.




