

Parking information for the Head of the Occoquan (HOTO) Regatta:

NO PARKING IS ALLOWED ALONG VAN THOMPSON, HARRIVAN, OR HAMPTON ROADS. Please be respectful of our neighbors and do not park along the roadsides. You may be ticketed or towed.

Follow @SandyRun and @RowOBC for parking updates.

Athletes and Coaches may park onsite in D lot and Loisvale Lot until parking is full. There is a fee to park on site. If onsite parking is full, athletes and coaches will need to park at the offsite location and ride the shuttle to the park.

Athletes or coaches parking on site must pay a fee of \$30 per car. Cash only.

Car toppers may park on site for free adjacent to the gravel trailer lot, or in B lot if space is available. There is no parking fee for car toppers.

Drop offs are permitted at the park in Lot C. Please pull forward as directed by the parking attendant, then continue straight and exit out the black gate.

Handicap vehicles may park onsite in C lot until parking is full. Handicap vehicles parking on site must pay a fee of \$30 per car. Cash only.

Pickups are permitted in C lot when your athlete is in C lot and ready to be picked up. There is no area available at the park to wait for your athlete. Alternatively, your athlete may ride the shuttle from the park to the offsite parking location for no fee and be picked up offsite parking, which has plenty of space available to park and wait.

Spectators may not park onsite at the park. All spectators must park at the *VDOT Commuter Lot, 1365 Old Bridge Rd, Woodbridge, VA*

The shuttle fee is \$10 per person round trip (ages 12 and under are free), collected at the offsite parking location when you board the shuttles. Cash only.

Team busses and vans may park on site until parking is full. Team vans park in D lot or Loisvale Lot until parking is full. Team busses park in B lot until parking is full. If your team bus arrives later than 8am on Saturday or 7am on Sunday, there may not be parking available. Once busses are parked onsite, it is very difficult for drivers to leave and come back, due to the rigging and movement of boats. Please notify your driver that they may want to find an offsite area (such as the shopping center parking lot on 123) to park and wait.

Team boat trailers may park in the gravel trailer lot during the following times ONLY: Friday 1pm-7pm, Saturday 6am-7am or 5:30pm-7pm, Sunday 6am-7am. Do not arrive outside of these times. Our space is limited and quickly becomes congested and difficult to navigate. You must communicate with or be parked by park staff or a HOTO volunteer when you arrive to Sandy Run.

Team tents may be set up Friday between 1pm-7pm, or Saturday or Sunday morning before 7am. Team tent spaces are assigned, and your site number is provided by the regatta organizer. Utility trailers may be unloaded but cannot remain parked on site. Chuck wagons/food trailers are not permitted on site. Open flames, propane, or cooking on site is not permitted per Fire Marshal guidelines. If you have items to drop off to your team, you may use the drop off lane in C lot after 7am on regatta days, and you must

communicate with someone from your team to walk up to the drop off lane and receive the items from you.

Volunteers may park on site for free if parking is available but must have the e-mail/pass that was provided.
