### **NATURE OF WORK**

An LIT assists Camp Overlook staff in conducting summer camps at Potomac Overlook.

### **EXAMPLES OF WORK**

- Assists with preparation for camp activities. This includes logistics for field trips, materials for craft and art activities, setting up for various activities (such as the end-of-camp potluck), and games/scavenger hunts etc.
- Assists in camper behavior management
- Provides active support for camp programs. This includes assisting campers with projects and presentations, pairing with campers during activities, and assisting park staff with demonstrations of activities.
- Present self as a strong and positive role model for campers.
- Performs related work as required.

### **QUALIFICATIONS**

- Must be at least 15 years old.
- General desire to work with children.
- Positive attitude
- Ability to relate effectively with the campers and parents.
- Ability to remain calm in stressful conditions.
- Ability to work in sometimes hot and humid conditions for long periods.
- Ability and desire to learn skills and information related to job
