RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. You must be at least 16 years old with a valid driver's license or other valid identification in order to be an occupant of a rental boat.
 - 12 to 15 years old must be accompanied by an adult at least 21 years old in the same or separate boat.
 - 11 years old and under must be accompanied by an adult at least 21 years old in the same boat (may not paddle solo or operate a paddleboard).
2. A personal flotation device (PFD) is required for each person on the water.
 - 11 years old and under are required to wear a PFD at all times.
3. Rentals charges are allotted based on the amount of time spent on the water
 - All day rentals must be returned 30 minutes prior to close.
 - Remove all trash and fishing equipment from the boat.
4. Load and unload passengers in the boat rental area only.
 - Swimming is prohibited.
5. Pedal boats shall not leave the areas indicated by **RED buoys**.
6. In accordance with State Law, alcoholic beverages are prohibited.
7. The following are prohibited at all times:
 - Bumping boats together.
 - Standing up in a boat, paddleboards excluded.
 - Splashing and horseplay.
8. Return to the dock at the specified return time. All-day rentals must be returned 30 minutes prior to close.
 - A \$10.00 late fee is applied after the first 15 minutes and then every 5 minutes.

VIOLATIONS OF THE ABOVE RULES AND REGULATIONS WILL RESULT IN REVOCATION OF BOATING PRIVILEGES.

WAIVER AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

The Renter agrees to abide by the above rules and regulations of the Northern Virginia Regional Park Authority (NVRPA) and the rules, regulations and laws of any municipality, state, county, federal or other authority in the area in which the equipment is operated. The Renter, in consideration of the rental of NVRPA equipment, hereby release and hold harmless NVRPA and its officers, directors, agents, servants and employees of all responsibility in case of any type of accident, personal injury and property damage while on the grounds or in NVRPA boats. Further, the Renter is responsible for the safety of all guests they may have in the boat.

Renter assumes complete responsibility for all NVRPA equipment and agrees to pay for any damages to the boat and/or loss of equipment from the boat during the period the boat is rented. In the event of a breach of this contract by the Renter, the Park Authority shall be entitled to recover its cost, including reasonable attorney's fees, incurred in enforcing its rights herein.
