Federal consistency determination letter for the Coastal Zone Management Act from the Department of Environmental Quality if project is within the Coastal Zone Management Area
Proof of public comment. Must include: - Certification of publication - Summarization of public comments - Summarization of any changes made to the project as a result of public commenting
